Section-3 Instructions to Bidder(s) (ITB)

3.1	- The bid shall be furnished under single stage-two-part bidding basis i.e., Technical-bid and Price Bid as per tender document's terms and conditions. - Tender documents shall be published on GeM Porta and AIESL website www.aiesl.in. - The complete tender documents can be downloaded from AIESL website. - Bidder(s) shall be required to submit bids for supplying the following two types of services. Fixed Cost Services - GHEs Leasing Required to operate 24*7 for a total of 13 line items in 18 Qty (Refer Section-5.2 for details). Optional Cost Services - Manpower (Operator and Helper) support as and when required during the contract period (Refer Section-5.3 for details).	
3.2	AIESL reserves the right to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any of the bids, without assigning any reason whatsoever at any stage.	
3.3	Bid Submission: Bids should be submit through GeM in two parts: Technical bid-Part I - Price bid - Part II - Both the bids should be submitted through GeM on or before the due date and time. - The Bids submitted after the due date and time shall not be considered. - Both the bids shall be opened separately. Price bid shall be open after evaluation of technical bids. Price bid will be open of qualified bidders only.	
3.4	Contract duration : - Contract shall be signed with Successful Bidder(s) for supply of GHEs Leasing Required to operate 24*7 under "Fixed services" and manpower support under "Optional services" at Air Force Hindon station for a period of two (02) years , AIESL may opt to extend the contract by another two years (extension shall be on year on year basis. ie 1st extension for 3rd year followed by 4th year extension) as mutually agreed by both the parties. However, this extension shall be based on satisfactory performance of Successful Bidder(s) and on same terms and conditions except for the additional incorporation of one price escalation applicable during the extension periods of third and fourth year as illustrated in clause 2 below: - One price escalation of 5% shall be considered during the extension periods of third and fourth year. This escalation cost of 5% shall be calculated on the basic price applicable for the first two (02) years cost. For example , if L-1 bidder is offering any service for Rs 100000 plus tax / royalties during the first two years then an escalation of 5% of Rs 1,00,000 =Rs 5000 plus tax/royalties shall be applicable for the third and fourth year. Thus the basic price for 3rd year and 4th year shall be Rs.1,05,000 plus applicable taxes/royalties. - However, contracts with successful bidder(s) can be terminated or short-closed by giving three (03) Months advance written notice by AIESL without assigning any reason thereof, entirely at its discretion. In such an event, Bidder(s) shall not be entitled to any compensation, in any form whatsoever.

Bids prepared by the Bidder(s) shall contain all requisite information along with self-attested supporting documents as per details provided in the Tender. 7. If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail, and the total shall be corrected. 8. If for some reason, the Bid opening or submission date is declared a holiday, then the Bid submission/opening date will automatically stand extended to the same time of the next working day. 9. In case of discrepancy between unit price and total price, the unit price shall prevail.
3.7		1. Fixed Services of GHEs Leasing Required to operate 24*7 shall be availed by AIESL during the contract period as per tender terms and conditions. 2. Optional services of Manpower (Operator and Helper) support shall be availed by AIESL on per day basis as and when required during the contract period as per tender terms and conditions.
3.8		Bid Offer Validity: 1. The Bid(s) shall be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of Technical Bid. 2. Prior to expiry of the validity period of the bid(s), AIESL may request the bidder(s) to extend the validity period of the Bid(s). The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing. A Bidder agreeing to the request shall only be permitted to extend the validity period of Bid(s). All the terms of the RFP shall continue to be applicable during the extended period of validity.
3.9		Bidder(s) are advised to quote strictly as per terms and conditions of Tender and any deviation will lead to rejection. Vague and ambiguous replies and replies such as "Refer covering letter, conditions of Bid etc. shall be avoided. Such replies shall be deemed to be incomplete and may prevent the Bid from being considered by the AIESL.
3.10		Pre-Bid Meeting : 1. The purpose of the Pre-Bid meeting shall be to clarify the issues and to respond to queries received from the prospective Bidder(s). 2. The Bidder(s) are advised to send their queries as mentioned in Notice Inviting tender prior to the Pre-Bid date. AIESL shall not be obliged to respond to any request for clarification received after Pre-Bid date. 3. Bidder(s) shall raise their pre-bid queries in Pre bid meeting and on GeM through representation. Queries raised in writing shall be discussed during the pre-bid Meeting. Verbal or telecom queries will not be entertained prior to or during the pre-bid meeting. 4. Text of the questions raised, and the responses given, together with any responses prepared after the Pre - Bid meeting, shall be transmitted without delay (without identifying the sources of the question) to all participants of the Pre-Bid meeting. Any modifications or alteration to the Bidding documents listed in Tender that shall become necessary because of the Pre-Bid meeting, shall be made by AIESL exclusively through the issue of an Addendum / Corrigendum separately and shall be available on AIESL website. No separate press advertisement will be given for the same. Addendum and/or Corrigendum, if any, to the Tender, shall be referred to and taken into consideration by the prospective Bidder(s). It is the Bidder's responsibility to visit the said portal regularly for the aforesaid Addendum / Corrigendum as applicable. 5. Non-attendance of the Pre-Bid meeting shall not be a cause for disqualification of a Bidder. Interested Bidder(s) who desire to attend the Pre-Bid meeting shall communicate one day in advance to the Pre-Bid meeting scheduled date to make

Maximum 2 (two) representatives of each Bidder shall be allowed to attend the Pre-Bid meeting on the date fixed by AIESL. The Bidder(s) authorized representatives shall carry an authorization letter on the letter head of the Bidder duly Signed by the authorized Signatory for the Bidder, along with an identity card to attend the Pre-Bid meeting. 7. Inputs/suggestions/queries submitted by the Bidder(s) as part of the Pre-Bid meeting and otherwise will be given due consideration by AIESL. However, AIESL is not mandated to accept any submission made by the Bidder and the final decision will rest with AIESL.
3.11	Bidder(s) should conduct its own due diligence, investigations and analysis and should check the accuracy, adequacy, correctness, reliability and completeness of the assumptions, assessments, and information contained in this tender and shall obtain independent advice from appropriate sources at no cost to AIESL.
3.12	The information provided in this tender to the Bidder(s) is on a wide range of matters, some of which depend upon interpretation of law. The information given is not an exhaustive account of statutory requirements and should not be regarded as a complete or authoritative statement of law. AIESL accepts no responsibility for the accuracy or otherwise for any interpretation or opinion on the law expressed herein.
3.13	The Bidder(s) shall bear all its costs associated with or relating to the preparation & submission of its bids including of contract agreement but not limited to preparation, copying, postage, delivery fees, expenses associated with any demonstrations or presentations which may be required by AIESL, or any other costs incurred in connection with or relating to in bids. All such costs and expenses shall remain with the bidder and AIESL shall not be liable in any manner whatsoever for the same or any other costs or other expenses incurred by the bidder in preparation for submission of the bid, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bid selection process as contained herein.
3.14	Technical Bids shall only be opened on the day of opening of Tender. Price Bids of only technically qualified Bidder(s), after the evaluation of the Technical Bids, shall be opened at a later stage. Intimation will be sent to those Bidder(s) who qualify after the evaluation of the technical Bids.
3.15	Successful Bidder(s) shall be solely responsible for payment of wages, compliance of applicable labour laws/wage codes, payment of employee related statutory dues, insurance, settlement of disputes with their employees/or legal heir etc. with respect to the employees service personnel or their legal heir deployed by them at Air Force station, Hindon. AIESL will not have any responsibility towards manpower/staff deputed by successful Bidder.
3.16	Personnel deployed by Successful Bidder(s) staff shall be in proper uniform at bidder(s) own cost while working on duty at Air Force Hindon station.
3.17	Supervision and monitoring of Staff on duty shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder. Therefore, the bidder must have a provision for supervision and effective management of the contract without any extra cost to 'AIESL'. Bidder(s) will provide the SPOC (single point of contact) for the same.
3.18	In case there is a tie between two or more L-1 bidders, AIESL shall have a right to ask all the tied bidders to offer revised Price bid through password protected files in Email. The L-1 out of the revised bids shall be entitled for award of the contract.
3.19	1. There will be no splitting of contracts for both services (Fixed and Optional). 2. Contract shall be awarded for all equipment and all services (Fixed and optional) to one single party/bidder.

Section - 4 General Terms & Conditions (GTC)

4.1	The tender does not imply that AIESL is bound to select a bidder or to appoint the selected bidder.
4.2	AIESL reserves the right to cancel the entire tender or postpone or extend the last date of bid receipt including after the scheduled date of closing or to withdraw the Bid notice, without assigning any reason thereof, entirely at its discretion. In such an event, Bidder(s) shall not be entitled to any compensation, in any form whatsoever.
4.3	The rates quoted in the Price Bid should be clearly typed / written in figures and words free from over typing or over writing. The corrections, if any, must be authenticated by the full Signature of the person, who has signed the bid
4.4	The Price bids should be in Indian Rupees (INR) only.
4.5	Conditional discounts/credits, if any, shall not be given any consideration in the evaluation.
4.6	AIESL reserves the right to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any of the bids, without assigning any reason whatsoever at any stage.
4.7	Price bids of only those Bidder(s) who qualify based on evaluation of their technical bid will be opened and accordingly such Bidder(s) will be intimated.
4.8	The bid(s) is to be submitted after careful study and examination of the tender document, and after obtaining a full understanding and assessing the entire requirements/conditions/constraints. Bidder(s) are therefore advised to study the tender document carefully and expected services by AIESL/IAF before submitting their bids. The submission of a bid will imply that the Bidder(s) has read this tender, its terms & conditions and has fully understood the work scope, specifications, project execution and solution implementation requirements.
4.9	The Bidder(s) should bear all the costs associated with the preparation and submission of their bids, including the costs incurred in presentations, demonstrations etc. for the purposes of evaluation of the bids by AIESL. AIESL will in no case be responsible or liable for such costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
4.10	Determination of whether the bid complies with the tender requirements or not, will be at the sole discretion of AIESL.
4.11	Rejections of Bid(s) : The bid(s) are liable to be rejected forthwith, i.e., without being evaluated, on the following grounds. 1. Bids should be neatly filled/typed, all pages duly numbered, duly Signed and stamped on every page by an authorized Signatory of the bidder. Unsigned Bids will be rejected. 2. Bid(s) shall be rejected if these are submitted after the closing date/time of tender. 3. Bid(s) shall be rejected if Technical Bid submitted along without EMD. Bidder(s) claiming exemption shall submit relevant proof. 4. If both the bids are not submitted, i.e only the technical bid or only the price bid is submitted, then such bids will not be considered. 5. All information related to the price quoted by the bidder should be given only in the Price bid format. The technical Bid should not contain any indication of the price. In case the price quoted is indicated in the technical Bid, the Bid will be rejected, without any reference to the Bidder. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard. 6. If Bidder is quoting NIL charges/consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.
4.12	The basic price offered/agreed shall remain fixed till the completion of the contract except for the escalation for 3 rd & 4 th year specified in the tender document.
4.13	Any statutory increase in taxes / levies / duties in contract period shall be reimbursed by AIESL on submission of proof of payment by the bidder. Similarly, in case of any reduction in the taxes/ levies/ duties from the present level, the benefit will be passed on to AIESL.
4.14	During the Contract Period, if for any reason there is a downward revision in the prices, the

	Successful Bidder shall pass on the benefits of the same to AIESL.
4.15	Payment will be made through ECS (Electronic Clearance Service) / Wire transfer only after deduction of TDS as applicable.
4.16	Bidder(s) are advised to quote strictly as per terms and conditions of Tender and not to stipulate any deviation / exceptions.
4.17	Tender bids must be submitted in English language only. All documents requested in the tender to be enclosed in English language only. Do not enclose any link for downloading of any document requested in the tender document.
4.18	The successful bidder shall pass on any benefits arising due to lower taxation or change in input/raw material cost by virtue of some exemption by government or for any reasons during the contract/order.
4.19	Earnest Money Deposit : 1. An Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) must be deposited along with a Technical bid. 2. Bidder(s) must deposit EMD in Electronic form (wire transfer) only. 3. EMD of Rs 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Only) by the payment gateway of AIESL website - www.aiesl.in 4. Bidders shall make online payment of EMD using the AIESL web site: <u>https://forms.edugfix.com/aiengineering/add?formType=8489935188309188</u> The Bidder should mention the Tender number along with full name address in the Remarks of EMD. 5. Following Bidder(s) shall be exempted from EMD subject to the submission of relevant proof a. MSEs as defined in MSEs Procurement Policy issued by Department of MSEs and whose credentials are validated online through udyog Aadhar. Bidder(s) shall submit valid "Udhyam" certificate along with the bid. b. Bidder(s) registered with the Central Purchase Organization or the concerned Ministry or Department. Bidder(s) shall provide relevant proof along with the bid. c. Startups as recognized by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). Bidder(s) shall submit valid "Startup" certificates along with the bid. 4. Bids received without EMD (except bids seeking exemption as per tender terms) shall be rejected. 5. MSEs/Startups should be registered for the required services (i.e. Aviation industry/Equipment leasing) of tender documents in order to claim the EMD exemption. 6. The registration certificate issued from any one of the above agencies must be valid as on the close date of the tender. The Successful Bidder shall ensure that the same is valid till the end of the contract period. 7. EMD for Bids which fail to qualify in the 'Technical Bid' shall be returned free of interest within 45 days of declaration of result of Technical Bid evaluation. 8. EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned free of interest within 45 days after receipt of Performance Security / PBG. 9. EMD submitted by the bidder shall be forfeited, if the bidder withdraws or modify or impairs or derogates from the bid in any respect within the period of validity of its bid or If it comes to notice that the information / documents furnished in its bid is false, misleading or forged or fails to furnish requisite performance security / PBG within stipulated time required as per Tender.
4.20	(Micro and Small Enterprises) MSEs : 1. <u>Public Procurement Policy</u> for MSEs Order, 2018 has been notified under section 11 of MSMED Act, 2006. It refers to the preferential treatment given to MSEs (Micro and Small Enterprises) in the procurement process of the Government entities. 2. Purchase preference shall be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) <u>Order, 2012 (dated 23.03.2012)</u>. At present , it is 15%.However,Bidder(s) are advised to refer to the latest notices and circulars of Govt. of

	India and the same shall prevail. - All MSEs must have registration as per provisions of the Policy i.e. registration with District Industries Centre (DIC) or Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) or Khadi and Industries Board (KVIB) or Coir Board or National Small Industries Commission (NSIC) or directorate of Handicrafts and Handlooms or Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum or any other body specified by Ministry of MSME. - MSEs must be registered for the required Goods or Services of tender documents in order to claim the price preference. - The registration certificate issued from any one of the above agencies must be valid as on the close date of the tender. The Successful Bidder shall ensure that the same is valid till the end of the contract period. - MSEs Bidder(s) shall be given relaxation in prior turnover and past experience subject to meeting of quality and technical specification of tender documents. - Total order qty shall be awarded to MSEs subject to matching of L-1 Price as per below details in order to create a balanced approach that consider both the L-1 Bidder and MSEs Bidders: - Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid will be termed as L1. If L1 Bidder is an eligible MSE, the contract of total order quantity shall be awarded to L1. - If the Lowest Bidder (L-1) is not an MSE and in case participating MSEs are quoting price within the price band of L1+15% then these MSEs shall be invited to match the L-1 price. First opportunity shall be given to MSE which is quoting less than other MSEs within the price band of L1+15%. Such MSE who is able to match the L1 price shall be allowed to supply total order qty and contract shall be awarded to that MSE accordingly. - In case such lowest eligible MSE fails to match the L1 price, the next higher MSE within the margin of L1+15% shall be invited to match the L1 price and so on and the contract shall be awarded to that MSE accordingly. - In this way, opportunity shall be given to a maximum of Three (03) MSEs within the margin of L1+15% to match the L1 price. In case, If there is no eligible MSEs (maximum of 03 MSEs) within L1+15% price band who is able to match the L1 price then the total order qty shall be awarded to L1 Bidder.
4.21	Exemptions: MSEs and Startups will be given 100% exemptions in EMD, Turnover and past experience subject to meeting conditions specified in paras 4.19, 5.4 and 5.5.
4.22	Performance Bank Guarantee - A Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) @ 5% of the contract (PO) value would be required to be submitted by the successful Bidder within 30 Days from the date of award of contract. The SD / PBG is for meeting the project commitments till the end of the contract period (including extension periods). The PBG would be refunded / returned within two months of successful completion of contract period without any interest subject to adjustment for penalties, if any, on account of deficiencies in performance as per the terms of the contract. - Performance Security shall be furnished in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Bank Guarantee (including e-Bank Guarantee) from a Commercial bank or online payment in an acceptable form safeguarding the purchaser's interest in all respects. - Performance Security should remain valid for a period of sixty (60) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including warranty obligations. - It is to be noted that the costs involved in furnishing the PBG / SD are to be borne by the Successful bidder who has been awarded the contract.
4.23	In case, if a successful L1 Bidder backs out and is not able to supply Services either before signing a contract or issue of Purchase order / LOA or subsequent to its issue, AIESL shall forfeit the EMD and will take the necessary action as deemed fit. Such Bidder(s) will not be allowed to participate in the future bids of AIESL for next one year.

4.24	The bid amount shall be inclusive of packing, transportation, insurance, delivery, unloading of Equipment charges and any other charges as applicable as per tender documents. Taxes, Levies and royalty if any as applicable shall be reimbursed by AIESL.
4.25	AIESL reserves the right to ask the Bidder to submit proof of payment against any of the taxes, duties, levies indicated within specified time frames.
4.26	Payment Terms: 1. Fixed and Optional Services a. The payment shall be made to successful Bidder(s) on a monthly basis for “Fixed services” towards “GHEs Leasing Operational support. b. Successful Bidder shall raise invoice on monthly basis subject to successful delivery of services at Hindon station as per tender terms and conditions. c. Invoices/Bills for monthly GHEs leasing required to operate 24*7 based on actual GHEs provided and certified by AIESL SPOC at Hindon station. d. Invoices/Bills for monthly manpower based on actual manpower deployed as required by AIESL for smooth operation and certified by AIESL SPOC at Hindon station. 2. Optional Cost Services a. AIESL shall avail manpower (Operators/Helpers) support at Hindon station as and when required for IAF’s aircraft operation on a per day basis. b. Bidder(s) shall provide the minimum qty of Operators and Helpers in each shift as per tender documents at Hindon station. c. Successful Bidder shall raise monthly Invoices/Bills on actual rendered monthly manpower support of Operators and Helpers to AIESL for smooth operation of IAF’s aircraft fleet. d.
